### Animals including humans

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Adult</b>	A fully grown animal or plant.
<b>Young</b>	<b>Offspring</b> that has not yet reached adulthood.
<b>Offspring</b>	The child of an animal.
<b>Eggs</b>	Laid by a female animal containing the developing <b>offspring</b> .
<b>Larvae</b>	<b>Young</b> form of the insect.
<b>Life Cycle</b>	The changes living things go through to become an <b>adult</b> .
<b>Hatch</b>	The emergence of <b>young</b> animals from their <b>eggs</b> .
<b>Develop</b>	To grow bigger and become stronger.

Some animals give birth to **live young**.

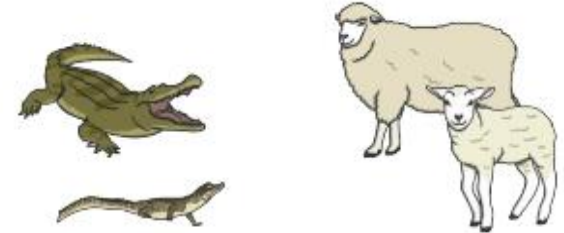


Some animals lay eggs which the **young** hatch from.



Both of these types of **young** then **develop** into **adults**.

Some **offspring** look like their **adult** when they are born.



Some **offspring** do not look like their **adult** when they are born.
