The **Osted inspection report** is now published and attached as a PDF of the report. A points about it:



- The phrase "Pupils meet the school's high expectations and achieve well" is the **most important insight** into the standards at school.
- · Though not surprised, I was very pleased that children's behaviour and engagement in lessons came out as really good. With all the trips and interesting curriculum we provide it was great to read that the inspector viewed that the children are inspired by their learning.
- · It was re assuring that the inspector judged our provision for children with special needs as effective at a time when all schools are having to adapt to the huge increase in special need demands.
- $\cdot$  Instead of one or two areas to improve, we only have one area and that is to tweak our action plan so that it more precisely and clearer steps incorporates Early Years (Nursery/Reception).
- $\cdot$  We were a little surprised that the key member of staff given a special mention by name has four legs and is focused on food not learning!  $\odot$
